Thursday, August 4, 2022

The Silver Lake Village Council held a special meeting on Thursday, August 4, 2022, at Silver Lake Village Hall, 2961 Kent Road, Silver Lake, Ohio. The meeting was in-person only.

With Council President William M. Church presiding, the meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. Mr. Church led the Pledge of Allegiance.

These members were present and responded to roll call: Mr. Dann Nivens, Mr. Matthew Plesich, Mr. William Church, Mrs. Therese Dunphy, Mrs. Betsy Meyer and Mr. Christopher Scott. Members of Council present were 6; members absent were 1, Mr. Phil Kaplan. Council excused Mr. Kaplan. Council reconvened at 6:45 p.m.


The Clerk-Treasurer gave Council a handout on how a 8.5% COLA and a 4.25% COLA would affect the Village [attached].
