ORDINANCE NO.: 69-2003

VILLAGE OF SILVER LAKE

INTRODUCED BY: Mrs. Steiner

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF SILVER LAKE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council finds that eight years have elapsed since any modification has been made in the salary of the Mayor, and that the salary herein approximates the earlier salary adjusted for inflation over eight years; and

WHEREAS, Council further finds that the complexity of providing needed governmental services and the demand for higher levels of service by the citizenry has increased steadily over the years, and that, as a result, the office of Mayor now entails greater time requirements and increasing levels of expertise, all of which demonstrate a need for an adjustment in compensation for such office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Silver Lake, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Mayor elected to the term commencing January 1, 2004 and each term thereafter shall receive compensation in the amount of One Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars (\$1,875) per month.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Silver Lake is hereby authorized to pay the Mayor on a monthly basis at the above stated rate effective January, 2004.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the Village of Silver Lake and the inhabitants thereof, by reason that it is immediately necessary to determine the salary of council members before the filing deadline for the November, 2003, election, and provided it receives the necessary affirmative votes as required by the Village Charter, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
