

ORDINANCE NO.: 43-2018

VILLAGE OF SILVER LAKE

INTRODUCED BY: The Administration

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR RESERVING VILLAGE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council finds it necessary to offset the cost of maintenance of Village recreational facilities by charging fees for usage of such facilities

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Silver Lake, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. That the following fees and related rules for reservations of the herein named Village recreational facilities, be, and the same are hereby enacted:

- a. Pavilion;
\$25 for residents
\$40 for non-residents
\$50 security deposit (for both residents and non-residents).
- b. Gazebo;
Free for residents
\$25 for non-residents
\$50 security deposit (for both residents and non-residents).

All reservations for the above are sunrise to sunset.

- c. Basketball court: No charge.
- d. Tennis / Pickleball court: No charge.
Court reservations may be made for a one hour period of time, but not in excess of two consecutive hours in one day.
- e. Baseball field:
\$10 per session, or any part thereof, for use on one day per week,
\$5 per session, in any part thereof, for use on multiple days per week,

All field reservations are 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Friday. Saturday, Sunday and other days when school is not in session, the time slots shall be 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. or 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

- f. A security deposit will be by separate check and returned when, and if, the Service Department verifies satisfactory condition of the premises.
- g. The Mayor may waive a rental fee for not-for-profit groups whose membership primarily resides in the Village.



h. All of the facilities herein may be reserved in accordance with the above by making a reservation on the form provided at Village Hall.


Section 2: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the Village of Silver Lake and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that the season for usage of the subject facilities is well under way, provided it receives the necessary affirmative votes as required by the Village Charter, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.




