Left (East) on Graham Road

Right (South) on Darrow Road

Right (West) on Route 59 (Past Silver Lake PD)

Continue on Route 59/2nd Street

Right into Cuyahoga Falls Police Department (pause for brief memorial)

Left (South) 4th Street

Right (East) Broad Bd

Left (South) State Road/North Main/S High Street (past Akron PD)

Left (East) E Turkeyfoot Lake Road/ 619 (past Summit County SO district office/Green Fire)

Right (South) S Arlington Road

Left (East) Greensburg Road

Left into Summit County Sheriff's Training Center (end of route)
