Road Paving

This year Perrin Asphalt won the paving bid. The roads involved are Silver Lake Blvd – (between Vincent and Highland), Millboro – (between Bellaire and Lakeland Parkway), Chautauqua, and Orchard. The start date is unknown at this time. Please limit the use of these roads during the paving project once it starts.

Please observe road safety signs

Service Department employees are out in full force working on various projects and work orders throughout the Village. Please observe the signs the Service Department posts on the roads as they are working. Do not attempt to go through a “Road Closed” sign for your safety as well as for the safety of our employees.

Water Line Assessment

Since I became Service Director in 2012, I have a company come in and check our entire water system for unseen underground leaks. Every year they have found two to four leaks which we promptly repair saving the Village thousands of dollars. This is done in the summer after we flush the fire hydrants. You may see them driving around on their four-wheelers with a flashing safety lights. The entire process takes only one day to check 16 miles of water line.

- Your water/sewer utility bill will be automatically deducted directly from your bank account in cooperation with your bank.
- Automated Clearing House (ACH) is a safe, reliable, and no cost way to pay your bill.
- The utility bill amount is withdrawn from your account on the 20th of each month or the next business day if it falls on a weekend/holiday.
- Utility customers will continue to receive a copy of their utility bill each month.
- You may stop ACH at any time by submitting written notice to the Silver Lake Utility Department.
