Prior General Membership Meeting September 18

The National Register of Historic Places & Homes in Silver Lake

Silver Lake resident and Garden Club member Courtney
Zimmerman provided a very informative overview of the criteria
that must be met for a place or property to be listed on the National
Register of Historic Places. Once she shared the criteria with us,
Courtney led an interactive discussion of homes in Silver Lake that
might be eligible, but we learned that there are no homes currently
listed. Being listed on the National Register does not prohibit
homeowners from making changes to a property. But often, local
governments have ordinances that require compliance, such as in
the case of historic homes in Hudson, OH. A word of caution, if
you have visions of listing your home someday, think twice about
replacing windows as that can be cause for disqualification!
