Prior General Membership Meeting: October 16

Linda Boardman from Dietz Florist created a beautiful fall floral *arrangement* which was raffled as a door prize to lucky winner Cec McDermott! Linda shared her insights and suggestions for long-lasting flower choices from our gardens or available from a florist. She also shared a useful tip for building a floral arrangement. Oasis, a Kent, OH company known for florist foam, also sells plastic-coated chicken wire. Linda shaped a piece of this wire into an egg shape and placed it inside a non-transparent floral container. Stems were cut long enough to have two points of contact in the sphere to hold the flowers and foliage in place securely. To refresh the water, remove the sphere with flowers intact, dump the old water and put fresh water in your container, then replace the sphere without any shifting of the arrangement! What a great idea! Linda stated that the coated wire may be available anywhere Oasis products are sold and at Dietz Florist. With these tips, we are ready to build our holiday centerpieces.
